Applications

Agrochemicals	PFC1-C.II.a, Straight inorganic micronutrient fertiliser – iron sulphate CMC-1, Virgin material substances and mixtures
	Quickly gives an intense green color to grass and a blue color to hydrangeas
	Prevents and corrects iron deficiencies (anti-chlorosis ...)
Cement	Cement additive to prevent dermatitis or cement eczema by reducing chromium (VI)

Period of use in agrochemicals

Period of use	All year round as needed
	Ideal period from March to May and from September to October
Precautions	Avoid dragging the product onto slabs, borders and construction materials, by applying in calm weather and without wind
